## Collection of your Personal Information

We value your trust. In order to honor that trust, IntelliPay adheres to ethical standards in gathering, using, and safeguarding any information you provide.

We will ask you when we need information that personally identifies you or allows us to contact you. We will only store personal data that you reviewed and provided to us.

Like most websites, we gather site-visitation data automatically and store it in log files. This information includes internet protocol address, browser type, internet service provider, referring/exit pages, operating system and date/time stamp data. This data is not linked to our users.

## Use of your Personal Information

We use external payment processors to bill you for goods and services. We may be required to provide them with portions of your data simply to complete transactions. This policy does not extend to those external sites therefore you will need to visit those sites if you wish to learn more. A link will be available on the relevant pages on this site.

We may merge anonymous demographic information with sales data for research purposes.

We reserve the right to disclose your personally identifiable information and transaction data as required by law and when we believe that disclosure is necessary to protect our rights and/or to comply with a judicial proceeding, court order, or legal process served on our website.

## Control of your Personal Information

When you register, or otherwise give us personal information, we will not share that information with third parties without your permission other than the limited exceptions already listed. It will only be used for the purposes stated in this privacy policy.

IntelliPay will occasionally email notices, such as completions of transactions and management of your account (initiated by you). You will not be able to choose to unsubscribe to these mailing as they are considered an essential part of the provided service. Please note that you may receive notifications from payment processors as a result of payment transactions, and from identity providers (such as Facebook) when you start using our site through their service.

## Access to your Personal Information

We will provide you with the means to ensure that your personal information is correct and current. If you have filled out a user profile, we will provide an obvious way for you to access

and change your profile from our website. The only exception to this is you will not be able to change your first and last name, nor the email address you used to register.

### **Security of your Personal Information**

The security of your personal information is important to us. When you enter sensitive information on our site, your information is sent over an authenticated and encrypted connection using Secure Socket Layer (SSL).

We store your personal information only on servers with limited access protected by a variety of technologies and industry best practices to prevent unauthorized access, use or disclosure.

### **Use of Cookies**

Cookies are small text files that are stored on a user's computer by the browser. We use cookies to make our site easier to use.

Enabling cookies is required to use the site. Please note that modern browsers allow you to filter which sites are allowed to store cookies on your device.
